

Council Minutes

Regular Meeting

The Pinson City Council met in regular session in Council Chambers at 4410 Main Street on Thursday, January 23, 2020. Mayor Sanders led the invocation. Gabriel Agbali led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Mayor Sanders called for all opposed to say "no", all in favor say "aye." Councilor Churchwell made a motion to accept the minutes as written of the January 9, 2020, meeting. Councilor McCain duly seconded the motion. Mayor Sanders called for any discussion. As there was no discussion, Mayor Sanders called for all opposed to say "no", all in favor say "aye." Mayor Sanders" Let the record reflect both motions passed unanimously".

Councilor Roberts offered a motion to waive the reading of the January 16, 2020, minutes. Councilor Churchwell duly seconded the motion. Mayor Sanders called for all opposed to say "no", all in favor say "aye." Councilor Churchwell made a motion to accept the minutes as written of the January 16, 2020, meeting. Councilor Churchwell offered a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an amended contract for the purchase of real estate located in the Bradford Park area, in the amount of \$15,000.00 for 1.77 (+/-) acres. Councilor McCain duly seconded the motion. Mayor Sanders called for any discussion. As there was no discussion, Mayor Sanders called for a roll call vote with the following results:
