A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NAME OF A STREET

WHEREAS, Alabama Highway 75 runs through the center of Pinson from the Blount County Line southward to Birmingham, and

WHEREAS, the portion of Highway 75 between Highway 151 and Brumbeloe Drive is currently named Center Point Road and changes to Center Point Parkway from St. John Drive southward, and

WHEREAS, street signs along this stretch of highway bear differing names, some in close proximity to each other, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this change of name in the center of the City of Pinson, the close similarity of the two names, along with the other factors mentioned above, causes confusion and misunderstanding; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that renaming this stretch of Highway 75 would promote uniformity, clearer identity, and clarify any uncertainty, and

WHEREAS, Center Point Road is within the corporate limit and/or the police jurisdiction of the City of Pinson,

1. Center Point Road is hereby removed from Alabama 75 and renamed Pinson Boulevard from the intersection with Highway 151 to the intersection of Saturn Lane. The numerical portion of addressed shall not change as a result of this resolution.

2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to change any non-conforming sign along this highway at the expense of the City.
