

RESOLUTION NO. 22-08

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY AND JEFFERSON COUNTY, ALABAMA CONCERNING SUPPLEMENTAL SPEED CONTROL DEVICES ON CERTAIN STREETS

WHEREAS, Jefferson County, Alabama (the "County") has responsibility for certain public streets (Vise Road)(the "Streets") in the City of Pinson, Alabama (the "City");

WHEREAS, the County regularly exercises such responsibility by, among other things, placing and maintaining street signs and other traffic control devices on and along those Streets;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to add supplemental speed control devices along the Streets by funding, constructing, and installing speed control devices, including but not limited to speed humps, signs, and pavement markings; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to accept the responsibility for all supplemental speed control devices, subject to the terms of the agreement that is the subject of this Resolution.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINSON, ALABAMA while in regular session on Mar 3, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. as follows:


1. The Mayor is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City, to enter into the "Memorandum of Understanding," in the same or substantially the same form shown as shown in **Exhibit A** to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference.

2. The Mayor is further authorized to carry out the terms of such contract, and to execute such other and additional documents that may be necessary and/or required in order to facilitate the transaction described herein.


