
Whereas, Jacob Anderson is the first student to represent Pinson Valley High School at SkillsUSA HVAC competition, and

Whereas, Jacob Anderson competed as a freshman and sophomore and continues to master the craft, and


Whereas, Jacob Anderson represented Pinson Valley High School, the City of Pinson, and Jefferson County with superior skills and in a professional manner,
