A RESOLUTION CONCERNING PROPERTY AT 6219 KALEY LANE

WHEREAS, the City of Pinson is currently engaged in an eminent domain proceeding in Jefferson County Probate Court concerning the following real property located in the police jurisdiction of the city:

The SW 31.83 feet of Lot 8 and all of Lot 9, in Block 2, according to the Survey of Rogers Addition to Pinson, as recorded in Map Book 12, Page 85, in the Probate Office of Jefferson County, Alabama.

(the "Property");

WHEREAS, the Property lies adjacent to Pinson's Bicentennial Park, and the City wishes to expand the boundaries of said park;

WHEREAS, the City Council is agreeable to paying \$5,000.00 to the owners of the Property, to resolve the condemnation process and acquire the Property.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINSON, ALABAMA while in regular session on June 7, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. that the Mayor is authorized, on behalf of the City, to pay \$5,000.00 to the owners of the Property, to resolve the condemnation process and acquire the Property.


