**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE 40th
ANNIVERSARY OF THE JEFFERSON COUNTY
LIBRARY COOPERATIVE**

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Library Cooperative was established in 1978 with a mission to link all locally-funded city libraries in the county in order to provide all citizens with resources and community opportunities that inspire life-long learning; and


WHEREAS, currently there are twenty-two member libraries – with forty locations – offering countywide sharing of countless services and resources with the “One County, One Card” system; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Library Cooperative works behind the scenes to coordinate the core services that link the forty libraries including: delivery service from one library to another, holdings of almost two million items in the forty libraries countywide, in-person and online holds on items at any library in the county, text messaging reminders, 24/7 catalog, downloadable audio and e-books, information databases, internet access and free Wi-Fi, Books-By-Mail for the homebound, and IT support for member libraries.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINSON, ALABAMA while in regular session on September 6, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby proclaim that the City of Pinson is proud to recognize the significant work of the Jefferson County Library Cooperative on its 40th Anniversary.
2. And that September, National Library Card Sign-Up Month, shall be a celebration of the cooperative relationship between public libraries in Jefferson County, including the Pinson Public Library.
3. Further that, all citizens are encouraged to stop by our own Pinson Public Library as it hosts a Birthday Celebration for Jefferson County Library Cooperative on Monday, September 10th, 2018 from 4:00 PM to 5:30 PM.
