THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINSON, ALABAMA while in regular session on Feb. (21), 2020 at 7:00 p.m. as follows:

- 1. The City Council finds that the above-described conditions at 6886 Highway 75 constitute a public nuisance that threatens the public health, safety, and welfare, and that the same must be abated.
- 2. The Mayor and City Attorney are authorized to initiate civil litigation in the Circuit Court of Jefferson County, Alabama against the owner(s) and/or responsible parties with respect to the above conditions, and to cause the abatement of such public nuisance, and (where possible) to recover costs and expenses associated therewith.
