WHEREAS, the Pinson City Council recognizes the need and value in park and recreational opportunities for the City of Pinson and our residents; and



WHEREAS, the Pinson City Council finds it in the best interest of the City of Pinson and its residents to assist in the continuation of this partnership,


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
