Act grant opportunity to fund road and street construction, and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Pinson, Center Point, and Birmingham, and Greater Jefferson County would benefit from expanded and accessible industrial areas on the Pinson Valley Parkway, and

WHEREAS, The Pinson City Council finds it in the best interest of the City of Pinson to apply for the grant, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINSON, ALABAMA while in regular session on June 4, 2020 at 7 p.m. as follows:

1) The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the attached grant application for an Industrial Road parallel to Highway 79 planned to run from Carson Road to Sunrise Drive. The City of Pinson hereby applies for the grant for the section of road within the Pinson City Limit. The total project cost is estimated at \$4,800,000. The current City of Pinson stretch is approximately

1/3 of the length and the grant is stated as an 80/20 grant, with the applicant(s) funding 20%.

2) The Mayor is further authorized and directed to execute any other item to comply with the intent of the resolution.
